5 Treat the tester as a new sailor, and explain what's happening to the sails etc. Get them involved.					
6.Demonstrate how to attract the safety boat					
7. Arrange for the safety boat to come and throw you a line. Demonstrate how you would attach it to the dinghy for towing. Be towed for 100 metres, steering. Disengage towline.

9. Approach pontoon, stop head to wind, and make a perfect landing.
