1. Start boat at <u>inside</u> of pontoon, and drive out to position between Manly E and Manly W YA marks		
2. Do a radio check with Manly Sailability		
3. Drive the boat in a figure of eight around the YA marks, in forward and reverse		
4. Drive up to YA mark and stop within a metre and without touching, both in forward and reverse.		
5. Tester to throw a fender overboard. Driver and observer to retrieve "MOB" When possible, practice with a real person		
6. Driver to demonstrate anchoring technique in appropriate water, suggest off Delmar beach		
7. With the cooperation of a competent skipper come alongside a dinghy so it can be held fast, drive a short distance in this position		
8. With the cooperation of a competent skipper in a dinghy, throw them a line, and instruct the skipper in the method you think most appropriate to tow them		
9. When secure, tow dinghy back to the pontoon through the moorings.		
10. Come alongside inside pontoon and make fast
